

Our Approach



- Combine topical lidocaine with dermal absorption/penetration enhancers
- Reduce time to initial onset of action of topical anesthetics
- Improve procedural patient comfort in a cost-effective manner to clinicians
- Improve topical anesthetic ease of access to clinicians by providing an inventory storing capable, regulatory-compliant product that does not require prescription
- Provide a high-margin "cash-and-carry" product throughout the distribution channel

- Topical lidocaine HCL 4% with absorption/penetration enhancers
- Lidocaine HCl 4% in a topical cream formulation
- When used properly topical lidocaine HCl 4% has minimal, if any, negative systemic effect
- Single, sanitary one-use application packaging for clinical settings use
- Multi-dose packaging for in-office dispensing to patients for residual pain management as well as cost savings to clinic

- Used to reduce pain locally when applied externally directly to the skin.
- Desensitizes without causing profound, uncomfortable sensations on the skin.
- Free of counter irritants known to cause localized skin irritation.
- Free of topical acetaminophen, salicylates and other NSAIDs
- ▶ Non-prescription, easy clinic and patient access
- Clinician and patient friendly, affordable pricing

Topical Anesthetic Applications

Can be used for:

- Minimally invasive procedures
- Aesthetic procedures
- ▶ LASER procedures
- Micro-needling
- Injections and venipuncture
- Discomfort management caused by cutaneous allergy reactions/inflammations, minor burns, insect bites/stings eczema and contact dermatitis
- Discomfort management caused by hemorrhoids

- Retail dispensing MSRP \$38.95 per 2.2 ounce tube
- Wholesale volume discounts available*
